- **Public Information (PI)** — The purpose of PI service work is to provide accurate A.A. information to the public when requested. PI committees visit schools, businesses and community meetings for this purpose. They also serve as resources for our friends in the local media, emphasising our Traditions of anonymity, singleness of purpose and nonaffiliation, as well as offering A.A. public service announcements to radio and television stations.
- **Cooperation with the Professional Community (CPC)** — Members of these committees provide information about A.A. to those who have contact with alcoholics through their profession. This group includes healthcare, EAP and HR professionals; educators; faith leaders; lawyers; social workers; military professionals; government officials; and those working in the field of alcoholism. Information is provided about where we are, what we are, what we can do, and what we cannot do.
